

AZALEAS

- Azalea Kiusianum** – Covers itself with small light pink flowers, small leaves. Dense spreader 2' x 2'
- Coral Bells** – 2'-4' x 3'-5', pink flowers
- Girard's Fuchsia** – 2'-3' x 2'-3' ruffled bright fuchsia pink flowers
- Gumpo Pink** – Slow growing to less than 1' x 2', late blooming pink
- Pearl Bradford** – Low growing spreading 2' x 4', pink flowers very late
- Rosebud** – 3'-4' x 3'-4', late bloom medium pink hose-in-hose flowers, look like a rosebud when opening
- Flame Creeper** – Low growing groundcover type to 1' tall, coral-orange flowers
- Everest** – 4' x 4', compact spreading habit, white flowers
- Glacier** – 5' x 5', rounded bright green leaves, upright spreading growth, white flowers
- Treasure** – 4' x 4', open spreading habit, white flowers
- Flaming Silver** – 3' x 3', eye catching variegated foliage, bright red flowers

2'-3' x 2'-3', crimson flowers

Sherwood Red – 3'-4' x 3'-4', orange-red flowers

Stewartsonian – 4' x 4', brick red flowers

Vuyk's Scarlet – 2' x 2', deep red flowers,
foliage turns dark red in autumn

Blue Danube – 3' x 3' spreading habit,
blue-violet flowers

Purple Splendor – Loose spreading habit, 3'-4'
x 3'-4', purple hose-in-hose flowers
