FALL LAWN CARE

Here's some advice to help ensure a lush, green lawn next spring.

- Apply lime at 25 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. This is an important step. Lime sweetens the soil and enables your lawn to absorb nutrients much more effectively. It also helps reduce moss problems.
- Apply a fall/winter lawn food such as Scott's Super Turf Builder with Winterguard or Dr. Earth Super Natural Lawn Food (strongly recommended where water pollution may be an issue). This is the year's most important feeding, strengthening the lawn against winter damage and preparing it for growth in the spring.
- It's the best time of the year to remove thatch from existing lawns if it's needed. It's also a good time to aerate if your lawn had problems absorbing water this summer.
- If you have problems with moss, wait until the moss is green and actively growing before treating it. Moss control products will not work on brown moss.
- The same is true for lawn weeds – wait until they are green and growing, and then spot treat as necessary.
