

RHODODENDRONS

* = sun tolerant

***Anah Kruschke** – 6' plant grows well in full sun, large dark foliage, medium sized trusses of lavender-blue late season

Anna Rose Whitney – Large 6' plus plant, large flower trusses of deep rose-pink mid-late season

***Baden-Baden** – Low growing 2' sun tolerant plant, dark green leaves with a slight twist, clear red flowers

***Blitz** – Compact sun tolerant variety to 3', dense deep green leaves, very dark red flowers mid-season

***Blue Diamond** – Small leaved, dense, finely branched, prefers sun, blue-purple flowers, 3' high and wide

Bowbells – 3' plant, nice oval leaves, new growth is coppery, buds are dark pink opening to light pink flowers

Capistrano – 5' mid-late season bloomer, medium yellow flowers

***Cherries-n-Cream** – Dark green leaves on a 2'x3' plant, cherry red buds open pink with darker reverses, early mid-season, takes full sun

***Chionoides** – 4' sun tolerant plant, bright white trusses of flowers



- Christmas Cheer** – 4' plant, very early light to medium pink flowers
- Cilpinense** – Attractive foliage and flower on this 3' hybrid – deep forest green small to medium leaves, early blooming blush pink touched with deeper pink flowers
- ***Cunningham's Blush** – Old reliable favorite, 4', takes sun, light pink flowers with a yellowish blotch
- ***Cunningham's White** – Sun tolerant variety growing to 4'. Numerous white flowers with greenish-yellow blotch
- Daphnoides** – Dark green rolled glossy leaves on a 4' plant, blooms deep purple pompom trusses
- ***Dora Amateis** – A low growing favorite, 3', mid-season pure white flowers, deep green foliage with bronze highlights, will grow in full sun
- ***Edith Bosley** – Nice deep green foliage on a 4' sun tolerant plant, dark purple flowers with a darker eye in midseason
- Elizabeth** – 3' somewhat fine textured plant, large red trumpet flowers early midseason
- Furnivall's Daughter** – 5' plant with tall trusses of bright pink flowers with a red blotch, midseason
- ***Gomer Waterer** – 6' sun tolerant plant, old standby still one of the best whites, buds are pink opening white with a golden green flare
- ***Hallelujah** – Award-winning Jean Marie hybrid with attractive deep green heavy textured foliage on a 4' plant, bright rose-red flowers borne in large trusses, tolerates sun
- Hello Dolly** – Rounded plant growing to 3', medium green leaves with light beige indumentum underneath, yellow flowers touched with orange and rose bloom early midseason

- Holden** – Compact dark green plant to 4', rose red flowers with a small red spot
- Honey Butter** – Nice medium green foliage on this 4' variety, beautiful yellow-orange flowers
- Horizon Monarch** – Large leathery bright green leaves and yellowish stems on this 6' plant. Impressive gigantic trusses of red buds opening to yellow flowers with a red flare, midseason
- ***Impeditum** – Tiny leaved variety slow growing to 1' high, 2' wide, intense violet purple flowers, likes sun
- ***Jean Marie de Montague** – Sun tolerant deep emerald green foliage to 5', the standard by which all other red rhodies are measured
- Karin Seleger** – Medium purple-violet flowers early in the season, grows 2.5' tall and wider than tall
- ***Lee's Dark Purple** – Reliable old favorite, takes sun, 6', deep purple flowers mid-late season
- ***Lord Roberts** – Vigorous glossy green plant to 5', will take sun, deep red flowers with a black blotch held in tight ball trusses, mid-late season
- Nancy Evans** – 3' free flowering plants, orange-red buds open to amber yellow
- ***Nova Zembla** – 5' midseason bloomer, tolerates sun, red-purple flowers
- ***Ocean Lake** – Small leaved sun tolerant variety, small blue-violet flowers, 3' high and wide
- Percy Wiseman** – Compact 3' plant with dark green foliage, trusses are formed of peach-yellow flowers slowly fading to white
- ***PJM** – Sun and heat tolerant 4' plant, rounded leaves are green in summer turning mahogany in winter. Early lavender pink flowers
- ***Ramapo** – Small leaved dwarf sun tolerant variety, 2' high and wide, abundant violet-purple flowers

Shamrock – Nice compact plant only 1' high and wider than tall, unique chartreuse flowers early in the season

***Sappho** – Open growing 6' plus plant with somewhat narrow olive green leaves, takes sun. White midseason flowers with prominent dark purple blotch borne in rounded trusses

Scintillation – Deep shiny green foliage with a slight curl, 5' plant, large midseason pastel pink flowers with dark pink flared markings in the throat

***Solidarity** – Fast growing 3' sun tolerant hybrid of Jean Marie, flowers open red fading to pale pink, midseason

***Springtime** – 5' plants, takes sun, late blooming pink with a prominent dark blotch

***Taurus** – Another great hybrid of Jean Marie, vigorous 6' plant with deep green pointed leaves, takes sun, glowing red rounded trusses early mid season

Unique – Thick, densely foliated 4' plant, beautiful pink buds open to buttery cream in early midseason

Variiegated Ponticum – Distinguished by its silver edged foliage, grows to 4' with orchid pink flowers mid late season

Vulcan's Flame – Deep green foliage with reddish stems, 5' bright red flowers mid-late season

***Wilgen's Ruby** – 5' plant, very deep red flowers with brown blotching mid late season, tolerates sun
